1.AGC Group Green Procurement Policy

(1) Green Procurement Definition

- ① Procurement for the raw material, parts and outsourcing products of the lower environmental impact
- ② Procurement for the raw material, parts and outsourcing products manufactured by the EMS and QMS maintained factory

(2) Green Procurement Supplier

- ① Manufacturer of the Raw material and parts that have a direct quality impact on AGC products
- ② Seller of the Raw material and parts that have a direct quality impact on AGC products as the administrator of the manufacturer
- ③ Outsourcing manufacturer of AGC products

(3) Green Procurement requirement

- ① The supplier must comply with all the environmental laws and regulations.
- ② The supplier must report to AGC research for the material substances which AGC nominates, accurately and keep submission deadline.
- ③ The supplier must have an authorized certification of EMS and QMS as a matter of principle.
- 4 The supplier must cooperate AGC environmental activities.

The material substance research shall be based on each in-house company guideline.

2.Requisition

- (1) Requisition for Purchase contract
 - ① Report of EMS and QMS authorized certification
 - 2 Submission of the environmental trading note
 - a Compliance with all the environmental laws and regulations
 - b Disclosure of the material substances
 - c Maintenance of the EMS and QMS certification
 - d Cooperation with AGC environmental activities
- (2) Requisition for Technical inspection
 - (1) Disclosed data of the material substances
 - 2 Reduction or substitution of high environmental impact substances

The requisition shall be based on each in-house company guideline.
