Asahi Glass Co., Ltd. (AGC) will build a new automotive glass plant near Tatabanya, Hungary to serve the growing market in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) and to support existing customers in the region. Initial investment will be approximately Euro 60 million over the next 3 years. The investment will be for a high technology automotive tempering glass plant. The construction of the plant will start within this year and the start of production is planned in early 2006. The company will hire 200 people for the new plant.

This investment follows automotive companies who are adding new capacity in the CEE region and more expansion is planned to meet growing demand for new cars. AGC is committed to creating the conditions by which it can bring the scope and level of support, which these automotive companies require. The region is the fastest growing area in the newly expanded European Union. It is forecasted that the growth in CEE region will be from 2.4 million carsets in 2003 to 4.1 million carsets in 2008. Demand for automotive glass and related value added products is also growing fast in this region.

Asahi Glass decided to invest in Hungary because of its close proximity to our customers, its infrastructure and the strong support from the government. Through this project, AGC will deliver high quality products and services to our customers.
